### A guided tour of a 17th-century renaissance park and Karls XI's memorial stones in Östra Sallerup, Hörby

#### **A truly historic place in the Scanian countryside!**

Prästgårdsparken or Karl XI's memorial stones are located southeast of Östra Sallerup's church in the heart of Skåne. It was established by a Danish priest Jöns Henriksson's during the turbulent war period of Sweden and Denmark in the mid-1600s. The park is one of a few preserved 17th-century parks in Europe.

In addition to the park, there is a 12th-century church. During the 1180s, Archbishop Absalon in Lund decided to commission a church on the hill in Östra Sallerup. Östra Sallerup church has some amazing historical connections with Lund, Copenhagen, and Stockholm. There is also a radio museum, a café, Kulturhuset and a burial mound from the bronze age.

Östra Sallerup is also known for hosting the Swedish Cavalry regiment where soldiers from various parts of the Swedish empire were employed but not many from Skåne. Swedish King, Karl XI established Southern Scanian Cavalry Regiment to counter the Danish invasion.

During this tour you will get to hear about, The Danish priest, Jöns Henriksson, Östra Sallerup church, Scanian Cavalry Regiment... You will get a taste of life in 17th century Scanian countryside. You will hear the exciting stories of how a small village in the middle of Skåne had connections to different parts of Sweden and the world during the late 1600s and early 1700s.
